## 2021 CLUB TRIAL CHAMPIONSHIP ROUND 3

DATE: SUNDAY 24th. October 2021 PERMIT No.: ACU 61449

**ANNOUNCEMENT:** - Huddersfield Falcon MCC will promote a Club Restricted Trial on 24/10/21 for solo motorcycles, held under the National Sporting Code, Standing Regulations of the ACU, the Yorkshire Centre Rules current at the time, the following Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions issued for the meeting (SUBJECT TO COVID19 RESTRICTIONS).

**ELIGIBILITY:** - Restricted to registered members of Huddersfield Falcon MCC. All riders must hold a current ACU Trials registration card or ACU Competition license.

MACHINES: - Motorcycles as per NSC Appendix D Category 1, Group A1 Solos and TSR 8.

**CLASSES:** Experts, Intermediates, Novices, Beginners, T/Shock, O40's, O60's, Pre. 65 and Youth A, B, C & D. There will be 3 courses to choose from – Championship (Hard), Clubman A (50/50), Clubman B (Easy).

START / VENUE: - 11.00 a.m. at Nethermoor Farm, South Crosland, Huddersfield, HD4 7BZ -

signposted off Blackmoorfoot Road by Sands House Pub (Map Ref. 110/116145)

No engines to be run before start time or until instructed.

Although all COVID19 RESTRICTIONS were lifted as from the 19<sup>th</sup>. July, the virus has not gone away and it is imperative that all who attend this event are mindful of that fact: Individuals need to take responsibility for their own safety and exercise judgement as appropriate. The event will be run under the current recommendations issued by the Government and the ACU and must be adhered to.

Anyone who has contracted coronavirus, exhibited symptoms, been in contact with someone who has been infected with the virus, or requested to self-isolate in a ten-day period prior to the event taking place shall not travel to or participate/officiate at the event and will follow Gov.UK guidance/advice as appropriate'. All online entries are subject to approval of the Club, and Competition Number will be confirmed prior to day of the event.

Signing-on will be way of each rider displaying his / her Competition Number to the Trials Secretary who will be seated within a vehicle displaying the Club name, Event Permit, Supplementary Regulations and other relevant Notices.

It is recommended that All Riders practice "Social Distancing" when offloading / loading their vehicle, and whilst negotiating the course, particularly when inspecting sections, and preferably using a "one-way walk-thro" system with no excessive waiting or queuing; if there are already 6 riders waiting to attempt a section move on to the next section to prevent lengthy queuing.

DUE TO LIMITED PARKING AT THIS VENUE ENTRY WILL BE LIMITED TO A MAXIMUM OF 60.

CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES WILL BE 6.00 pm ON SATURDAY  $23^{rd}$ . OCTOBER (NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON THE DAY) ENTRY FEE OF £16.00 / £8.00 (ADULTS / Youths 16 and under), plus Falcon Club membership of £5\* for 2021 if not already paid, to be made electronically. At the time of entry you will need to take out ACU Trial Registration / Licence if you haven't already done so (ONE DAY LICENCES WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE). \*Club Membership can be paid online also

**RESULTS: -** Will be e-mailed to Competitors who provide an e-mail address, as well as being published on the Club's "Facebook" page and web site <a href="https://www.falconmcc.co.uk">www.falconmcc.co.uk</a> (Results will also be published on ACU Website).

**AWARDS:** the outright winner on each course will be awarded a £5.00 (equivalent) voucher on each trial, class winners will receive a £3.00 voucher; in both cases providing a minimum 3 riders take part. Other awards may be awarded at the Organiser's discretion.

NB. SOUVENIR TROPHY AWARDS PROVISIONALLY MAY BE MADE AT THE NEXT FALCON MCC DINNER & AWARDS EVENING IN EARLY 2022 (if Covid-19 restrictions allow).

**COURSE:** - All on private land and will generally be a minimum of 4 laps of eight or ten sections (to be decided on the day). There will be 3 courses to choose from – Hard, Clubman B (Easy) & Clubman A (50/50) - first section will close by 3.00pm at the latest by the Observer pulling out the course markers. Sections shall generally be ridden in correct order on each lap, subject to queuing qualification above. The onus on finding the sections is that of the competitor, the route will be clearly marked and should be closely followed.

**METHOD of MARKING:** - As per TSR 22b; stop NOT permitted. Ties will be resolved as per TSR 23. Failure to attempt a section will incur a 10 mark penalty in accordance with ACU Rules; alternatively you can incur a 5 mark penalty, but only if you request this off the Observer rather than attempt the section (this ruling applies to closed-to-club trials only).

To be classified as a finisher riders must attempt at least 75% of the sections.

PROTESTS: - any appeal situation can only be dealt with electronically after the event, under National Sporting Code of the ACU section 10.04.
