ANNOUNCEMENT: - Huddersfield Falcon MCC will promote a Club Restricted Trial on 27/12/20 for solo motorcycles, held under the National Sporting Code, Standing Regulations of the ACU, the Yorkshire Centre Rules current at the time, the following Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions issued for the meeting (SUBJECT TO COVID19 RESTRICTIONS).

ELIGIBILITY: - Restricted to registered members of Huddersfield Falcon MCC. All riders must hold a current ACU / SACU Trials registration card or ACU / SACU Competition license. Any rider or passenger from another FMN must produce a Licence issued by their FMN together with start permission and proof of personal accident insurance.

MACHINES: - Motorcycles as per NSC Appendix D Category 1, Group A1 Solos and TSR 8.

CLASSES: Adults: Experts, Intermediates, Novices, Beginners, T/Shock, O40's and Pre 65. **Youth:** A, B, C & D. class
There will be 3 courses to choose from – Hard, Easy (Clubman B) & 50/50 (Clubman A)
NB. all with the emphasis on fun rather than a “World Round”!

START / VENUE: - 11.00 a.m. at HORN HILL, NEW MILL, HOLMFIRTH, near HUDDERSFIELD, HD9 7DH –
off A635 near Toss o'Coin PH (O/S Map Ref 110/174086

COVID19 RESTRICTIONS: Due to parking restrictions and to maintain appropriate “Social Distancing” measures this Trial is open to a maximum of 45 riders *(including Award Winners).

*PS. There will be an Award Ceremony at 10.30am before the trial in respect of the MICHAEL ROCK MEMORIAL EASY TRIAL SERIES.

As the venue is in a “Tier 3” area only competitors from a Tier 3 area who live within 30 miles will be allowed to enter.

Should any entrant display any coronavirus symptoms, or be confirmed positive as part of the Test and Trace Programme, he / she should STAY HOME, along with anyone else in the same household or support bubble.

All online entries are subject to approval of the Club, and Competition Number will be confirmed prior to day of the event.

Only riders from the same household or “support bubble” should travel in the same vehicle. Parked vehicles must leave at least one clear space (minimum 2m) from other parked vehicles.

Signing-on will be by way of each rider displaying his / her Competition Number to the Trials Secretary who will be seated within a vehicle displaying the Club name, Event Permit, Supplementary Regulations and other relevant Notices.

All Riders must practice “Social Distancing” when offloading / loading their vehicle, and whilst negotiating the course – only 3 riders allowed to inspect a section at one time, preferably using a “one-way walk-thro” system – no excessive waiting or queuing; if there are already 6 riders waiting to attempt a section move on to the next section to prevent lengthy queuing.

RIDERS DISOBEYING SOCIAL DISTANCE REQUIREMENTS IN ALL CASES WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY DISQUALIFIED AND MAY FACE FURTHER ACU DISCIPLINARY ACTION WITH SUSPENSION RECOMMENDED.

NO SPECTATORS WILL BE PERMITTED.

PRE-ENTRY ONLY VIA ACU ONLINE ENTRY SYSTEM www.acu.org.uk CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES WILL BE 12.00 noon ON WEDNESDAY 23rd. DECEMBER (NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON THE DAY)

ENTRY FEE OF £15.00 / £5.00 (ADULTS / Youths 16 and under) , plus Falcon Club membership of £5* for 2020/21 if not already paid, to be made electronically. At the time of entry you will need to take out ACU Trial Registration / Licence if you haven't already done so (ONE DAY LICENCES WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE).

*Club Membership can be paid online also

NOTE: You can cancel your entry online up to the closing date, or inform the Trials Secretary by e-mail up to the day before the event, but there will be a £3.00 Admin charge. No refunds will be given for no show on the day.

RESULTS: - Will be e-mailed to Competitors who provide an e-mail address, as well as being published on the Club's "Facebook" page and web site www.falconmcc.co.uk (Results will also be published on ACU Website and on Trials Central).

AWARDS: This is a "Fun Trial" and novelty prizes will be presented at the discretion of the organising team, but as a minimum there will be awards presented for overall **BEST INDIVIDUAL PERFORMANCE** on each course and for 1st in each Class, with a special award for the rider who the Observers decide has competed in the best "Spirit" of the event (FANCY DRESS IS ENCOURAGED!)

COURSE: - All on private land and will generally be a minimum of 3 laps of eight sections (to be decided on the day). There will be 3 courses to choose from – Hard (Red / Blue flags), Easy (Red / Blue & Yellow / White flags) & 50/50 - first section will close by 3.00pm at the latest by the Observer pulling out the course markers). Sections shall be ridden in correct order on each lap. The onus on finding the sections is that of the competitor, the route will be clearly marked and should be closely followed.

METHOD of MARKING: - As per TSR 22b; NO STOP permitted. Ties will be resolved as per TSR 23. Failure to attempt a section will incur a 10 mark penalty in accordance with ACU Rules; alternatively you can incur a 5 mark penalty, but only if you request this off the Observer rather than attempt the section (this ruling applies to closed-to-club trials only). To be classified as a finisher riders must attempt at least 75% of the sections.

PROTESTS: - as per the National Sporting Code of the ACU section 10.04.

PLEASE NOTE: - ACU Licences must be available for inspection on request

Parking is limited at this venue; please share transport wherever possible (but only in compliance with Covid-19 Restrictions).
