ANNOUNCEMENT: - Huddersfield Falcons MCC will organise a Centre Restricted Trial on Sunday 27th April 2024 for solo motorcycles, held under the National Sporting Code, Standing Regulations of the ACU, the Yorkshire Centre Rules current at the time, the following Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions issued for the meeting. **This event is a round of the new Yorkshire Clubman Championship.**

ELIGIBILITY: - Restricted to registered members of Clubs affiliated to Yorkshire Centre ACU. All riders and passengers must hold a current ACU Trials Registration / Membership or a SACU licence or ACU/SACU rider's licence. Any rider or passenger from another FMN MUST produce a licence issued by their FMN together with start permission and proof of personal accident Insurance. These must be available for inspection on request

MACHINES: - Motorcycles as per NSC Appendix D Category 1, Group A1 Solos and TSR 8.

ELECTRIC bikes are welcome but entrants must be aware of the perceived fire risk attributed to these machines and must take necessary precautions to minimise the risk, including providing a standby Fire Extinguisher as recommended by the Bike or Battery Manufacturer (The Club will provide a Dry Powder extinguisher located adjacent to the signing-on vehicle)

CLASSES: - Clubman A Route: - Over 45 Experts, Over 45 Intermediate, Clubman (Novice) and Youth A & B
Clubman B Route: - Clubman (Novice), Pre65, Twinshock, Air-Cooled Mono and Youth A, B & C
Small Wheels / Conducted Course: - Youth C, D & E

NOTE: Subject to sufficient entries being available Experts & Intermediates under 45 years of age can ride on a non-competitive basis. Riders can also ride out of Class on a no-points basis.

Adults & Youths will be awarded points separately down to 15th. place (20, 17, 15, 13, 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1)

At the conclusion of the Championship the points from each rider's results for all rounds will be added together and the rider with the highest number of points in their class will be champion, subject to having competed in at least 3 rounds and being a member of a Yorkshire Centre Club.

Best Performance on Clubman B (Easier) Course. an Award + £50.00 Voucher to spend at Road and Trials.

1st, 2nd. and 3rd in each class on each course (other than main award winners) – an award. (Subject to at least 3 entries in each class)

*(Trophy to be held for one year only).

NB. ALL MAIN AWARDS TO BE MADE AT THE YEAR END FALCON MCC DINNER & AWARDS EVENING IN EARLY 2026.

COURSE: - All on private land, to consist of a minimum 3 laps of 12 sections on a CLUBMAN A & CLUBMAN B course.

Sections shall be ridden in correct order on each lap. The onus on finding the sections is that of the competitor, the route will be clearly marked and should be closely followed. There will also be a Small Wheels / Conducted course for the Youth C, D & E categories.

Actual number of sections and laps will be confirmed on the day along with the method of closure or time limit.

METHOD of MARKING: - As per TSR 22b (No Stop); except TSR 22a (Stop-Permitted) on Small Wheels / Conducted Course only.

Ties will be resolved as per TSR 23

PROTESTS: - as per the National Sporting Code of the ACU, section 10.04
