SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS BRIAN CLARKSON MEMORIAL TRIAL

(Sponsored by Road and Trials, Barnsley)

ANNOUNCEMENT: - Huddersfield Falcons MCC will be holding the above event on Sunday 27th September 2026 which will be held under the National Sporting Code of the Auto Cycle Union, the Trials Standing Regulations, and the Yorkshire Centre Rules current at the time, together with these Supplementary Regulations and any Final Instructions issued in accordance with TSR 21. **This event is a round of the Yorkshire Clubman Championship.**

ELIGIBILITY: - Restricted to registered members of Clubs affiliated to Yorkshire Centre ACU, ADULTS & YOUTHS A-C. All riders must hold a current ACU Trials Registration / Membership or a SACU licence. Riders from other Federations must produce a licence and start permission confirming Insurance issued by their own FMN. On the Day / One event insurance cover will not be available. This event will not include use of the Public Highway but the terrain is not suitable for Youth D & E or Conducted Course classes.

MACHINES: - Motorcycles as per NSC Appendix D Category 1, Group A1 Solos and TSR 8.

ELECTRIC bikes are welcome but entrants must be aware of the perceived fire risk attributed to these machines and must take necessary precautions to minimise the risk, including providing a standby Fire Extinguisher as recommended by the Bike or Battery Manufacturer (The Club will provide a Dry Powder extinguisher located adjacent to the signing-on vehicle)

CLASSES: - Clubman A Route: - Over 45 Experts, Over 45 Intermediate, Clubman (Novice), Youth A & B.
Clubman B Route: - Clubman (Novice), Pre65, Twinshock & Air-Cooled Mono, Youth A, B & C

NOTE: Subject to sufficient entries being available Experts & Intermediates under 45 years of age can ride on a non-competitive basis.

Riders can also ride out of Class on a no-points basis.

Adult & Youth Points will be awarded separately down to 15th place (20, 17, 15, 13, 11, 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1)

At the conclusion of the Championship the points from each rider's results for all rounds will be added together and the rider with the highest number of points in their class will be champion, subject to having competed in at least 3 rounds and being a member of a Yorkshire Centre Club.

Best Performance by a Youth on the Clubman B (Easier) Course – an Award + £20.00 Voucher to spend at Road and Trials.

1st, 2nd, and 3rd in each class on each course (other than main award winners) – an award. (Subject to at least 3 entries in each class)

NB. ALL MAIN AWARDS TO BE MADE AT THE YEAR END FALCON MCC DINNER & AWARDS EVENING IN EARLY 2027

COURSE: - All on private land, to consist of a minimum 3 laps of 12 sections on a CLUBMAN A & CLUBMAN B course.

Sections shall be ridden in correct order on each lap. The onus on finding the sections is that of the competitor, the route will be clearly marked and should be closely followed.

Actual number of sections and laps will be confirmed on the day along with the method of closure or time limit.

METHOD of MARKING: - As per TSR 22b (No Stop); except TSR 22a (Stop-Permitted) on Small Wheels / Conducted Course only.

Ties will be resolved as per TSR 23

PROTESTS: - as per the National Sporting Code of the ACU, section 10.04
